With seven seasons on Hulu, this show will be both nostalgic but great for those who are already looking forward to the Halloween season.

#### "The Midnight Club"

Mike Flanagan's "The Midnight Club" is also perfect for the Halloween season. The Netflix show follows a group of terminally-ill teenage patients who share scary stories in their club which meets at midnight at their hospice facility.

Though the series is spooky,

it is not as horror-filled as some of Flanagan's other hits, such as "The Haunting of Hill House," "The Haunting of Bly Manor" and "Midnight Mass."

You can watch all of Flanagan's shows on Netflix. Though beware "The Midnight Club" was canceled after its first season, so if you don't like cliffhangers you should avoid watching it.

#### "American Horror Story – Coven"

"American Horror Story" is an award-winning anthology series – meaning each of its seasons follows a different plotline and characters which are not necessarily related to each other.

Though you can look through all other seasons for which one

sounds the most interesting, "Coven" would be a great choice for this fall. The Emmynominated third season of the show follows a group of witches living in New Orleans as they attempt to decide the fate of their coven.

You can watch all "American Horror Story" seasons on Hulu. A new season, named "Delicate," will also premiere this Wednesday. It follows a famous actress who has undergone multiple failed attempts of IVF and now believes there is something more sinister targeting her and her pursuit of motherhood.

#### "Bates Motel"

A spin on the horror classic "Psycho," this show is a modern prequel to the 1960 movie of the same name. It follows Norman Bates as a teenager and the disturbing relationship with his mother Norma Bates. The show begins when Norma buys a motel in the small town of White Pine Bay, but murder quickly ensues in the duo's attempt at a new beginning.

The psychological horror show features familiar names like Freddie Highmore, Vera Farmiga and Olivia Cooke.

The show is available for streaming on Apple TV+.

#### "Twin Peaks"

This classic mystery drama premiered in the 90s and follows FBI agent Dale Cooper's investigation into the murder of a girl in the small town of Twin Peaks, Washington.

The show is a cult classic that has become more mainstream in recent years. If you haven't already seen it, you can check it out on Paramount+.

#### "Chilling Adventures of Sabrina"

# Dorm-friendly recipes to try this fall

While Florida doesn't have falling leaves or temperatures, crisp students can still get into the fall spirit by breaking out their sweaters, cozy fall decorations and pumpkins.

College life may not allow for a five-course pumpkin spice-flavored meal, but these recipes offer dorm and budgetfriendly options for students to bring fall to their on-campus homes.

#### Microwave pumpkin mac and cheese

With few а substitutions and an open mind, you can transform a box of mac and cheese into a fall meal in the comfort of vour dorm room.

Combine the noodles with I 3/4 cups of hot water in a microwave safe bowl. Microwave the uncovered noodles until the water is absorbed, pausing to stir every 2-3 minutes. This should take about 8-12 minutes total.

Prepare the box of mac and cheese as normal, but substitute the butter with pumpkin puree. Top with some nutmeg, cayenne pepper and paprika to add a little spice. Ingredients:

> I 7.25-ounce box of mac and cheese (\$1)

I <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cups water

• 4 tablespoons pumpkin puree (\$1.47) I/4 cup milk (\$1.67) Total estimated cost: \$4.14

#### Microwave pumpkin mug cake

For a quick and easy dessert to satisfy your late night pumpkin spice cravings, make this microwaved pumpkin mug cake. Be careful not to cook it for too long or you'll be scraping burnt pumpkin off your coffee mug all night.

In your favorite USF bookstore coffee mug, mix spice cake mix, pumpkin puree and milk. Put the mug in the microwave for about 70 seconds and top with some cream cheese frosting.

Ingredients:

- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cup spice cake mix (\$1.84) <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup pumpkin
- puree (\$1.47) tablespoon Ι
- milk (\$1.67) Optional: cream
- cheese frosting (\$1.74)Total estimated
- cost: \$6.72

#### Microwave sweet potatoes

This microwavebaked sweet potato is perfect for a restaurantquality dorm creation. Topping with sugar and spice turns this into a healthy fall snack. The best part? It only takes

five minutes.

Wash a sweet potato and pierce 3-5 times with a fork. Microwave the potato on a plate, rotating halfway through until soft. This should take about five minutes.

> Cut halfway through the potato and top with butter, spices and sugar. Let it cool a minute before eating.

Ingredients:

- I sweet potato (\$1)
- tablespoon • Ι butter (\$3.68) Cinnamon
- (\$1.18) Nutmeg (\$2.42)
- Brown sugar (\$2.18)Total estimated
- cost: \$10.38

#### Slow-cooker apple cider

Slow-cooker apple cider is the best way to make your dorm room smell like walking apple through an orchard under a warm, fall sun. This warm cider elevates your traditional store-bought apple juice to a spiced, flavorful drink.

Combine all the ingredients in а crockpot, stirring until the sugar dissolves. Cook on low for at least two hours and leave on warm for the rest of the day. Curl up in your bed with Gilmore Girls playing on your laptop and enjoy.

Ingredients:

• 8 cups apple

juice (\$1.98)

- 3 cinnamon sticks (\$2.68)
- 1 teaspoon whole cloves (\$2.98)
- teaspoon 1⁄4 allspice (\$1.94)
- 1/3 cup brown sugar (\$2.18)
- I orange sliced (\$0.88)
- I apple sliced (\$0.64)

Total estimated cost: \$13.28

#### Mini fridge pumpkin pie overnight oats

Overnight oats are the perfect make-ahead breakfast treat for students who swear by meal prepping. Use four 8-ounce containers to store the fall-flavored oats and enjoy them reheated or cold the next morning.


Mix <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cup of oats and I teaspoon of chia seeds in each container. Combine the remaining ingredients in a separate bowl. Pour the mixture into each evenly container. Close each container and shake well before storing in a mini fridge overnight. Ingredients:

- 2 cups quick oats (\$2.48)
- 2 cups milk (\$1.67)
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup pumpkin puree (\$1.47)
- teaspoons 2 pumpkin spice or a mix of I teaspoon of

- cinnamon, <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> teaspoon nutmeg, <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> teaspoon ginger and 1/8 teaspoon
- I teaspoon vanilla (\$4.12)
- 2 tablespoons maple syrup or honey (\$3.12) 4 teaspoons of chia seeds (\$6.49)
- Optional: 1/4 cup pecans (\$3.92)
- Total estimated cost: \$25.51







Halloween Horror Nights is a separately-ticketed event at Universal Studios Orlando that features haunted houses, scare zones, a live show and themed food. Tickets range from \$79.99 to \$129.99 depending on the night you attend, and the event runs on select nights through Nov. 4.

This year, there weren't many houses that disappointed – however, some shined brighter than others. Here's a ranking of all the houses, from worst to best.

#### 10 – Chucky: Ultimate Kill Count

Scares – This house leans more on comedy than horror, so if you're wanting a truly terrifying experience, it might be best to invest your time in another house. However, the house should get props for its unique scares. With a mix of puppets and real actors, there are some neat and comical moments watching the iconic killer doll unleash his wrath.

Sets and design – Though it features some fun moments with Chucky, there isn't a whole lot to be dazzled by compared to some of the other houses at the event – what you see is what you get. There is also a moment in the house where you walk outside to then walk back inside another building, which felt like a lull and took away from the overall excitement.

**Final thoughts** – While Chucky fans may find some enjoyment seeing the doll in action, the house as a whole pales compared to other jawdropping haunts the event has to offer.

Overall rating – 3/10


#### 9 – The Exorcist: Believer

With Halloween arriving next month, it's time for students to start picking out their costumes.

It can be tempting to buy full costumes from stores like Spirit Halloween, but the majority of those can end up costing anywhere between \$40-\$90. These prices aren't realistic for most college students, especially when they're typically only worn once.

Instead, here are some easy and cheap costume ideas for college students with a low budget.

#### **Black Cat**

To start out, students can go for the classic cat costume. Though this is one of the more basic options, it is still cute and affordable for any Bull. For a black cat, the main components are the cat ears, which can be bought at Amazon for around \$10 dollars or \$4 at Walmart.

Besides the cat ears, all you will need is an all-black outfit for the rest of the costume. This look can also be modified for different animals like a bunny or bear by changing the outfit color and ears to match the animal.

#### Devil

Another classic costume is a devil. Like the cat costume, this consists of an all or mainly red outfit with devil horns. If you do not have any red items, an allblack outfit could still work for the devil.

Devil horn headbands can be found at Five Below for around \$2.

#### Cowboy/Cowgirl

A cowboy costume is an easy and cute idea for country fans. The main items needed are a cowboy hat, which can be found for \$13 on Amazon or \$11 at Walmart, and cowboy boots. Cowboy boots can be expensive, but if you don't already have a pair, cheap ones can be found at Walmart for \$25.

A bandana can be added for an extra touch but is optional and can be found at Hobby Lobby for \$1. The rest of the outfit is up to you, but typically these costumes include jean shorts and flannels.

#### Barbie

Currently the movie of the year, "Barbie," also gives great options for easy costumes. To dress as Barbie, the main focus is pink. Any pink items can be put together for an affordable but still recognizable costume.

To go for a more direct look, attaching the name 'Barbie' to a white shirt will only set you back around \$6 for letters from Michaels or around \$5 for a patch at Hobby Lobby.

Here are some items you can wear for different Barbies:

- Cowgirl Barbie: Pink pants, pink vest or tank top, white cowboy hat and a pink bandana.
- Weird Barbie: Pink dress, brightly patterned or mismatched socks, short blonde wig and face paint/make-up.
- Workout Barbie: Pink leotard, pink visor or baseball hat, leggings and leg warmers.

The different accessories for the Barbies can all be found at Walmart. A short blonde wig for Weird Barbie can be found for \$7 and the face paint can be found for around \$3 at Walmart. Workout Barbie's pink visor and leg warmers can be found for \$3 each.

#### Men in Black or Suits

A suit can be played two ways for different pop culture costumes. It could be used to cosplay characters from the movie "Men in Black" or the show "Suits."

This requires a blazer, a collared shirt, black bottoms and a tie. Many thrift stores carry these items at affordable prices. Nearby thrift stores include the Salvation Army Family Store or Community Thrift Store.

#### Mystery Inc.

A cute budget group or individual costume would be members from Mystery Inc. -Shaggy, Velma, Daphne, Fred or Scooby.


Most of the characters wear clothes that would be easily found thrifting or already in your closet. Here are the items you can use for each character:

- Shaggy: green V-neck • shirt and brown pants.
- Velma: orange turtleneck, a red skirt, glasses and long orange socks.
- Daphne: purple dress, a green scarf and a purple headband but the dress could easily be substituted for a purple shirt and skirt.
- Fred: blue collared shirt, white sweater, blue pants, and an orange scarf.
- Scooby: an all-brown outfit, dog ears and his signature blue collar.

The scarves, which are the parts least likely to be in your closet, are only around \$8 on Amazon.

For Scooby's costume, Target has a Scooby accessory set for \$14. Another alternative is to buy brown dog ears that can be found at Walmart for around \$7 and a teal ribbon can be used as his collar which can be found at Michaels for around \$1.50.

Good Halloween costumes can be hard to think of, but breaking the bank isn't necessary. You can find cute budget-friendly costumes by combining clothes from your own closet with inexpensive and easy-to-find accessories.

As the summer heat starts coming to an end, cooler temperatures and an exciting autumn season are near. Take a look at some things happening around Tampa Bay that will help you and your friends get in the festive and spooky spirit.

#### Sweetfields Farm Fall Maze

Located in Masaryktown, Sweetfields Farm is located 40 minutes north of the USF campus.

Sweetfields Farm opened in 2008 and is a small family owned and operated farm.

The farm offers a little something for everyone to get in the seasonal spirit with activities such as a pumpkin patch, hay rides, a corn maze or even tasting their apple cider.

You can visit farm animals and can grab a bite to eat from one of the food vendors on site. For an additional charge, they also have pumpkin painting. These activities at Sweetfields run Friday through Sunday, starting on Oct. 6 and going until Nov. 5.

For ages 3 and up, admission is \$11.95 plus tax and ticket fee of \$1.33 each. Tickets must be prepurchased online.

#### Tampa's Oktoberfest

Tampa's Oktoberfest is always sure to get everyone ready for fall. This is a three-day German festival event located at the Curtis Hixon Waterfront Park, which is 10 miles south of USF campus.

There is plenty to do at this lively event from listening and singing along to live music, playing in the Bavarian games for your chance to win prizes and medals or even indulging in

#### brats and schnitzel.

This is a family-friendly and dog-friendly event. If you are 21 years old or older, Oktoberfest features the city's largest beer garden with a variety of brands for you to enjoy. Other fun challenges that will be featured include the beard and mustache competition, tug of war and Mr. and Mrs. Oktoberfest.

A single day ticket is \$10,
